The Board of Directors has begun evaluation of our congregational needs. To start, a survey asking a few pertinent questions was distributed through services two weeks ago. These results were discussed in Bible study last week and are as listed below with 178 returned in total...not all voted on every issue:

- Is BVLC prepared for a vacancy in the near future? Yes 105, no 58
- Is BVLC prepared if Pastor Jones stops leading Congregational Care? Yes 88, no 82
- Has BVLC fulfilled its vision to Connect, Grow & Serve? Yes 158, no 23
- Are there more opportunities to engage NWA communities? Yes, 158, no 16
- Would you support an associate pastor to lead Outreach and who would assist with Congregational Care? Yes, 132, no 32
- Lastly, would you support with prayer and finances the addition of an associate pastor? Yes, 130 and No 42 which is 75.58% in favor both with prayer and money.

Your Board of Directors feels the need and support are present in our growing congregation but cannot Call without the congregational approval AND financial commitment to fund the position. As more information becomes available, it will be disseminated to all.

Should any voting member of the congregation wish to be on the Board, elections will be the last Sunday of October. Please present your name to Hanni Griffin, our secretary, in the next two weeks.
