Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

This Sunday is the first Sunday in the Season of Lent, not the first Sunday in Lent. That sounds the same, but it's not. I remember as a boy that our family gave up something from Ash Wednesday through Holy Saturday, inclusive of all the Sundays. But, as a bright and enterprising confirmation age student, I eventually realized that the Sundays are not counted as part of the forty days of Lent. The only way you can count to 40 days of Lent within the Church Season of Lent each year is to leave out the Sundays. I was told by my pastor that Sundays, each being a celebration of the Resurrection like a little Easter, were not included in the 40 days of Lent.

So this Sunday is the first Sunday in the Season <u>of</u> Lent, not the first Sunday <u>in</u> Lent. That means if you wish to fully engage in the season of Lent you will need to join us on Wednesday evenings at 6:00pm. By the way, there is a meal served before each of these Services!

Today's Old Testament text from Psalm 91 radiates with confidence that God is our refuge in time of trouble. Jesus knew this as He was tempted in the wilderness, even though Satan tried to twist Scripture itself to tempt our Lord. Only when the Israelites entered the Promised Land was the wilderness behind them. On that forty year journey God kept them secure in His protection. Their first harvest would be tangible proof of God's keeping them in His care in the past as well as into the unknowable future.

Although we also waiver in our reliance on God, just as His Old Testament people did, our God-given faith in the Messiah, Jesus, assures us victory with and through Him.
