Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Each Christmas, we celebrate the birth of Mary's firstborn Son. This God-man, Jesus the Christ, is both fully human and fully divine, a completely unique person in all of history. While being sent in human flesh He is the only-begotten Son of God. Jesus has two complete natures; one fully human and one fully divine. And yet, those two natures are united in one person in the God-man, Jesus. He is not two persons; He is one person. So, you ask, why is this significant?

It is awe inspiring to know that Jesus' two natures are perfectly united in His one person. Jesus is not divided. He is not two people. He is one person. His two natures are without confusion, without change, without division, and without separation. Jesus is one.

This means Jesus is one focal point for our worship. Because of this one-person union, Jesus Christ holds an unparalleled magnificence. No one person satisfies the complex longings of the human heart like the God-man. God has made the human heart in such a way that it will never be eternally content with that which is only human. We are built to be transcendent, to be eternal. St. Augustine said it so well, "God, You have created us for Yourself, and our heart is not quiet until it rests in You."

And beyond just gazing at the spectacular person of Jesus, there is also the amazing gospel-laced revelation that the reason Jesus became the God-man was for us. His fully human nature joined in personal union to His eternally divine nature is permanent proof that Jesus, in perfect harmony with His Father, is absolutely for us. He has demonstrated His love for us in that while we were still sinners. He took our nature to His one person and died for us.

Our Savior came into this world for a purpose: to redeem, buy back, ransom, to take the place of and save everyone. To save you. To save me. And to save those around us that don't yet know about Him. This sacrificial lamb took your place. It is Him alone that we celebrate at Christmas!


